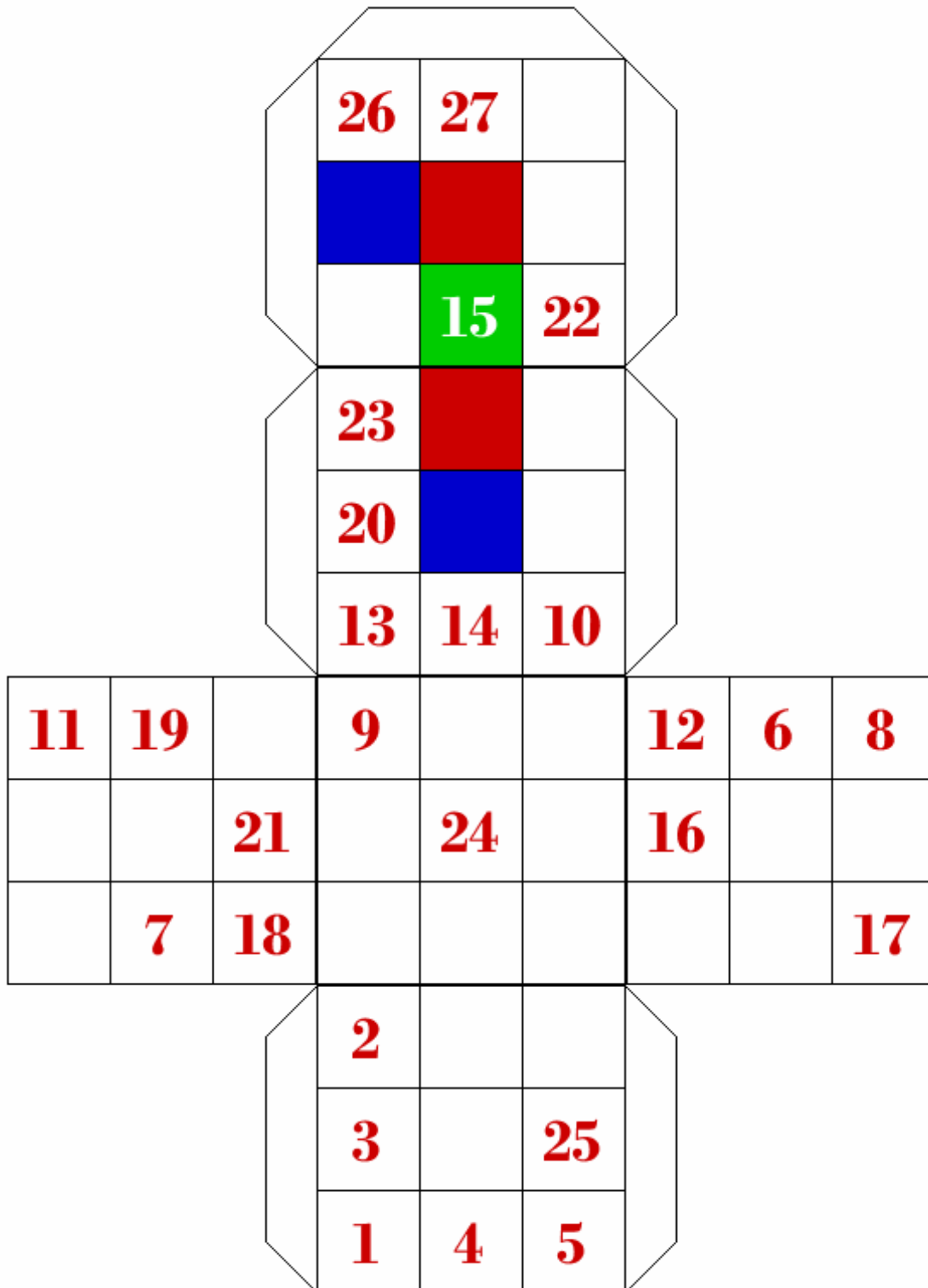


Lo, for the colors were three,
